### RELOADABLE King Soopers Purchase Cards



King Soopers Cards purchased from here forward are now **RELOADABLE** by YOU! Please keep the same card, and at your convenience, add dollars to it with your cash, check or credit card. **To reload**, simply add dollars in any amount up to \$500 to your card at the register **BEFORE** you ring up your groceries. Then, have your groceries scanned, and pay with your reloaded King

Soopers card—continue to use your King Soopers customer loyalty card for discounts. Another way to reload is to simply go to a register or customer service when you enter the store, and add dollars. If you checkout at a different register, it will take approximately 5 minutes to activate. We will receive **5%** back on all reloads. We have extra cards that you can reload on your next grocery shopping trip, so if you need additional cards, or a replacement card, please purchase from the Parent Guild, as cards purchased at the store will not benefit Cornerstone.

### **BoxTops for Education®**

Please continue to bring your boxtops in for our **BoxTops for Education®** program. **LAURIE HUTCHINGS** (mother of Kenny), continues to coordinate this program for us. We **greatly appreciate** her time and efforts.
